Biography of Mr. CM Kwok

Mr. CM Kwok is the Accredited Mediator and Coach of Hong Kong Mediation Accreditation Association Limited (HKMAAL) and the Hong Kong Mediation Centre (HKMC) respectively. He is currently Alternate Director of the Joint Mediation Helpline Office Limited (JMHO), Member of the Mediation Accreditation Committee (MAC) of HKMAAL and Council Member of HKMC. CM is also the Co-Chairperson of HK-China Mediation Experts Committee and HK-China Mediation Experts Panel Member of HKMC. He is a listed mediator of Lands Tribunal in Hong Kong.

CM has been active in promoting community mediation in Hong Kong and is a frequent speaker in mediation seminars. He was one of the guest speakers of the first Community Mediation Forum held in Hong Kong in May 2013. CM has authored articles on community mediation.
